Updation of mapper files response in banks database

Please refer to the standard operating procedure for Aadhaar seeding by the banks. For seeding the Aadhaar numbers into NPCI mapper the member banks are using the upload format, for every file uploaded by the banks the system will provide a response file. It is essential that the member banks use the response file to update the status of NPCI mapper against each Aadhaar number in their database so that the status can be accessed by the front office officials to answer the queries of the customer.

Please refer to our circular No: NPCI/2014-15/NACH/Circular No 67 dated December 05, 2014 where in the detailed guidelines are given for Aadhaar seeding in a new file format.

The input file and response file naming convention will be as follows

Input file: ACH-CM-KUNS-KUNSMaker-13022015-000005-MAP.txt

Response file: UID_Response--ACH-CM-KUNS-KUNSMaker-13022015-000005-MAP.xml

1. There is a possibility of all the records uploaded in the file are accepted by NPCI mapper then in such a case the format of response file generated is provided in Annexure I and XML format is provided in Annexure II.
2. If some of the records in the file are accepted and others are rejected then the format of response file generated is provided in the Annexure III and XML format is provided in Annexure IV.
3. The status / reject codes and their respective description is provided in the Annexure V.

Member banks are requested to be guided by the circular and make sure to utilize the response files to update the status in their databases and provide the view facility to their staff.

11	Invalid Aadhaar_No, Aadhaar number must not start with 1
