## Account number and beneficiary account holder's name to be mandatorily provided in APB return file

Reference may be taken from NPCI circular number 17 dated October 07, 2013 (copy enclosed) on the captioned subject.

It has been observed that a few banks are still not capturing and providing the beneficiary account holder's name and account number in the APB return file.

The APBS system is used for Direct Benefit Transfers and Subsidies from Governments department and Oil Marketing Companies. Hence the Ministries, Government Departments and OMCs (Oil Marketing Companies) want all member banks to mandatorily provide these 2 parameters in the APB return file to send SMS to the beneficiaries with these details, further the data will be useful to attend to the queries/complaints of the beneficiaries on receipt of benefits.

In view of the above, it has been decided to make Beneficiary account holder's name (40 digit alpha numeric) and Destination Bank account no. (20 digit alpha numeric) fields mandatory in APB return files sent by destination banks with effect from October 16, 2016. Even if the account holder's name is available in the inward file the destination banks should make sure that the name should be overwritten with the name as per their core banking system in the return file.

The return files without these two parameters will be rejected by the system. NPCI and the Government departments may contemplate penalty on the banks for non-compliance.



In-order to ensure meaningful data is captured in the return file, following validations will be done at NPCI in the beneficiary name & account number field

- o Beneficiary name validations
  - Only spaces will not be allowed
  - · First three alphabets cannot be consecutive
  - . It must be more than 3 characters
- o Account number validations
  - Only spaces will not be allowed

APB destination banks are advised to take immediate steps at their end to capture proper beneficiary account holder's name and account number in APB return file for DBT (inclusive of PFM) and DBTL products.

This is applicable for Aadhaar based transactions only.
