



## Abridged Minutes of NFS Steering Committee Meeting held on 27th June 2025

- 1. Members were informed about the circular released for the revision of interchange fees for ATM transactions.
- 2. Members were updated on the current status of enabling UPI-ATM (ICCW) at ATMs and for customers. Live members need to consider implementing reversals at their end as soon as possible.
- 3. Members were updated on the status of card-based Interoperable Cash Deposit (ICD) and UPI-based Interoperable Cash Deposit (UPI ICD).
- 4. Members were updated on the benefits of UPI ICD, which includes interoperability, allowing for wider acceptance via third-party account deposits. Members were urged to explore UPI ICD along the lines of third-party deposit use cases.
- 5. Members are expected to work towards enabling card-based and UPI ICD transactions as both Issuers and Acquirers.
- 6. Members were updated on international card transactions (DFS, JCB, and UPI card acceptance) on NFS member banks' ATMs.
- 7. Members were updated on the status of UDIR for NFS ATM transactions. Members are required to implement UDIR for NFS ATM transactions as soon as possible.
- 8. Members were updated on the status of self-attestation and were informed to submit the Self-Attestation of directives for FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25 at the earliest.
- 9. Banks with high technical declines need to work towards addressing the issues and controlling the decline.
- 10. Members endorsed the implementation of the updated dispute life cycle and documents.
- 11. Members endorsed the proposal that mentioned changes to the settlement process for Discover and JCB cards.
- 12. Other operational, risk management, and product-related matters were discussed, including adherence to RuPay technical specifications, updates on PCI PIN Security requirements on Key Block, etc.
