Subject: Mandate Management - Feature Enhancements in Version 3.0

Dear Members.

In reference to Circular No. NPCI/2025-26/NACH/003, we would like to inform you about the upcoming upgrade to the NACH 3.0 Mandate Management System (MMS). This upgrade has been formally communicated to all participating entities, including banks, corporates, and government departments, along with comprehensive implementation guidelines.

The purpose of this advisory is to provide a clear overview of the enhancement of **key features** being introduced as part of migration. These changes are specifically aimed at improving the **mandate search capabilities** and **document access functionalities** within the MMS platform. The enhancements are designed to streamline operations, enhance data security, and align with evolving regulatory and operational standards.

Key Feature Enhancements

1. UMRN-Based Search Functionality

- Mandates, including rejected cases, can now be searched using the Unique Mandate Reference Number (UMRN).
- The search interface remains consistent with the previous version to ensure ease of use.

2. Discontinuation of File Name-Based Search and File Downloads

- The system will no longer support file-wise search or file download options.
- Users are advised to utilize the UMRN-based search for mandate tracking and retrieval.

This change is for information security compliance.

3. Mandate Ownership and XML File Retention

- Mandates will continue to be initiated and maintained by sponsor banks and corporates.
- Sponsor banks and corporates will be responsible for processing and storing mandate-related
 XML files at their end.
- The system will not retain or provide access to download XML files once processed. Retrieval
 of these files post-processing will not be possible.

This change is for information security compliance

4. Mandate Data Access

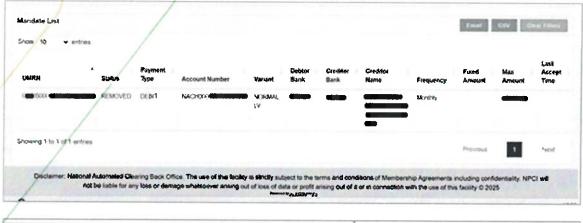
- Mandate data will be available for download in Excel or CSV format for reporting and analysis purposes.
- Associated mandate images will remain accessible via the UMRN-based search.

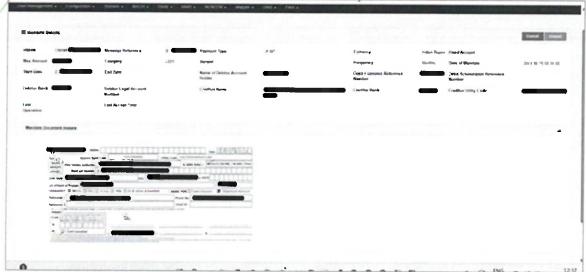
