Chapter 1 About NPCI

Chapter 2 Solution Objective

The Expression of Interest (EOI) is floated in order to identify bidders who can provide Network Behavior Anomaly Detection (NBAD) Solution to build profile of any anomaly and provide early indication of such exfiltration through network. The identified bidders through this EOI shall receive the detailed and specific RFP for supply and installation of such NBAD Solution.

Chapter 3 Scope of work

The broad scope of work shall include but shall not limited to the following:

- To install and configure Network Behaviour Anomaly Detection (NBAD) software solution at NPCI Data Center
- To enable SOC/IR team to receive alerts for suspicious network and user activities captured in the NBAD
- Bidder to ensure proposed solution (NBAD) integrates with all mandatory applications of NPCI such as Active Directory system for authentication and SIEM for log collections, etc.
- Bidder must create or provide use cases/POC documents for the solution prior to project sign off.
- The qualified / successful Bidder shall be responsible for arranging the entire POC related infrastructure, database, hardware and software, operating system, third party software etc. and all related cost shall be borne by the respective bidder except arranging the transport, lodging & boarding of the NPCI team. Although this is a POC, the appliances/ hardware proposed

by the bidder should have dual/ redundant power supply for each server/ components at both DC's and fiber gigabit NIC adapter connectivity.

- Bidder should demonstrate technical compliance requirements as mandated in this document for the solution implemented.
- Implementation of the solution should be done by OEM directly and not through partners (Resumes of the members to be included as part of EOI document)
- Bidder is expected to provide the onsite support if the technical issues are not remotely resolved.
- Solution should have the ability to take periodic backup of Application and Database which should help to restore the application back to earlier state (to be considered in POC)
- Bidder should provide support for O/S and D/B hardening support to close all the vulnerable points and Configuration Audit (per the policies defined by NPCI) for the servers that shall be provided by bidders.
- If the proposed solution is appliance base bidder approved /certified hardened document.
- Bidder to provide a brief walkthrough of the proposed solution The software supplied must be the latest version of the OEM. Beta versions of any software shall not be accepted
- The solutions should not have a significant impact on the production (existing infrastructure) of the NPCI either during installation or during operation of the solutions.
- Bidder should submit High level diagram (HLD) during technical presentation
- OEM to validate and certify the efficacy of every module / feature of the solution
- The solution shall be installed by Bidder, pursuant to the Expression of Interest (EOI) document relating to providing of the Implementation, training and assessment services.
- Bidder shall engage in providing solution design, installation, configuration, UAT, transfer of information and assessment of the solution to NPCI.
- Development of operating procedures in adherence to security policy of NPCI.
- The Appliances/ Hardware proposed by the bidder should be rack mountable at DC
- NPCI shall provide the network bandwidth for the in-scope solution. However, bidder is required to mention the bandwidth requirement for in- scope solution. It is expected that the proposed solution to consume minimal bandwidth, so that it should not impact NPCI day to day business operations.
- NPCI shall provide the required Ethernet switch ports. However, bidder is required to mention the number of Ethernet switch ports required for in- scope solution during technical presentation.
- Bidder should bring all the tools and equipment (Including cables) for successful commissioning of hardware and software for successful implementation of Solution
- Bidder should be responsible for performing all the adequate cabling activity related to Server, Storage, and LAN etc. of NPCI for successful commissioning of hardware, software, license etc.
- The bidder shall provide the detailed design document comprising of hardware (including configuration) with operating systems and other application software in their technical bid.

 - 6) Business and Technical SLA (Annexure O)
 - 7) Innovativeness (Annexure P)

5.2 Opening of Bids
