Change in OAC INP file for account number field

With reference to our circular No. : NPCI/2015-16/NACH/ Circular No 107 dated July 01, 2015 on conversion of old account numbers to new account numbers, please note that we have added validation to the old account number filed to accept only the account numbers that are equal to or less than 9 digits. The relevant technical specification is given below

Specification

In the record level of the INP file, between fields from 28 to 47 (old account number filed) only 9 digits account number can be updated.

INP files having more than 9 digits in old account number field will be rejected with reason "Old account number should not be more than 9 digits".

Member banks are requested to take a note of the same.
